DESTRUCTION OF BALLOT PAPERS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS USED IN BUKIT BATOK BY-ELECTION 2016

In accordance with the Parliamentary Elections Act (Chapter 218), ballot papers and other documents used in an election shall be sealed and retained in safe custody for a period of 6 months, after which they shall be destroyed, unless otherwise directed by order of the President. This is to ensure secrecy of the vote.

All sealed boxes containing ballot papers and other documents used in the Bukit Batok By-Election on 7 May 2016 will be transported from the Supreme Court, where they have been retained in safe custody, to the Tuas South Incineration Plant on 12 November 2016 for destruction by incineration.
