

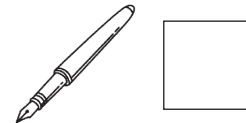
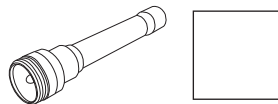
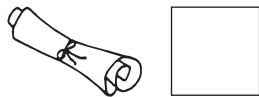
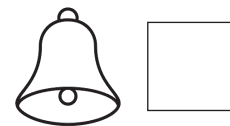
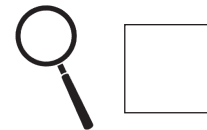
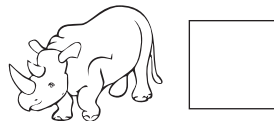
## CANDIDATE SYMBOL ON BALLOT PAPER
