- Singaporean politics is a matter only for Singaporeans to decide and should be free from foreign influence. To guard against foreign interference at Singapore elections, every candidate must submit to the Returning Officer a declaration that they did not cause or encourage any foreign influence in their campaign and had taken all practicable measures to ensure that their campaign did not benefit from foreign influence.

You must give to the Returning Officer a declaration that there was no foreign influence in your election not later than the 7<sup>th</sup> day after the final election result is published in the Government Gazette.
