


Download the *Oath of Secrecy and Appointment of Polling Agent* form (for polling agents)

 **By 06 Aug** (Polling Day)

 Polling agents at ordinary polling stations must be appointed by the candidate, his principal election agent or any of his election agent. The role of a polling agent is to observe that polling at the ordinary polling station is carried out in accordance with the law. He must also maintain secrecy of voting at all times.

To enter an ordinary polling station, each polling agent must submit a duly completed *Oath of Secrecy* form (original signed and attested copy) to the election officials at the first polling station he visits; and the *Appointment of Polling Agent* form for each polling station that he enters.

Polling agents may board the vehicle transporting the sealed ballot boxes from an ordinary polling station to the counting centre. The appointed polling agent must submit the duly completed and signed *Indemnity Form for Participation in Observing the Transportation of Sealed Ballot Boxes* to the election officials at that polling station before 6pm on Polling Day. Only one polling agent per candidate (or the candidate himself) may board the vehicle. If there is already one polling agent representing the candidate on the vehicle, any other polling agent representing the same candidate will not be allowed to board.
