You can **keep up to 4 drafts**. Your election agents will also be able to view and edit all drafts.

You may choose to submit your drafts for early checks by ELD to ensure that they are in order. **Submission of the draft Nomination Papers for early checks will be available until the day before the eve of Nomination Day.**

Once early checks are completed, you can proceed to have the verified Nomination Paper attested to. **Attestation must be done by the candidate and his subscribers, before a Commissioner for Oaths (CFO) or a Justice of the Peace (JP).** Candidates **must read the [explanatory material](#)**  **prior to making a statutory declaration in the Nomination Paper** that they understand the role of the President under the Constitution.
