-  Submit online
-  For each return respecting election expenses, the principal election agent of the candidate must submit the expenses incurred for the election, disputed and unpaid claims, and donations accepted by every election agent or the candidate. Both the principal election agent and the candidate will have to declare that the return is complete and correct, and that no other expenses of any nature have been incurred.

The submission will only be considered complete when the supporting documents (i.e. bills and receipts) are provided. You are strongly encouraged to provide the supporting documents in softcopy to facilitate processing. 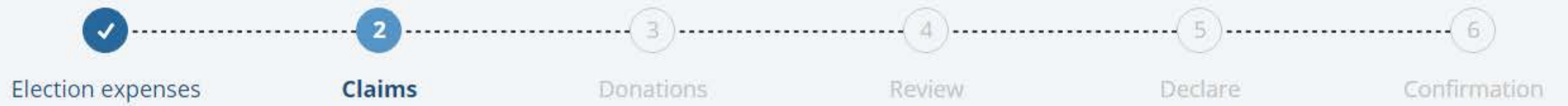
