 Submit online

 **Online Election Advertising (OEA) may only be published** by or on behalf of a candidate during the campaign period, **if a declaration by the candidate or any of his election agent is submitted to the Returning Officer.**

The first OEA declaration to the Returning Officer must be made within 12 hours after the start of the campaign period. The declaration must set out:

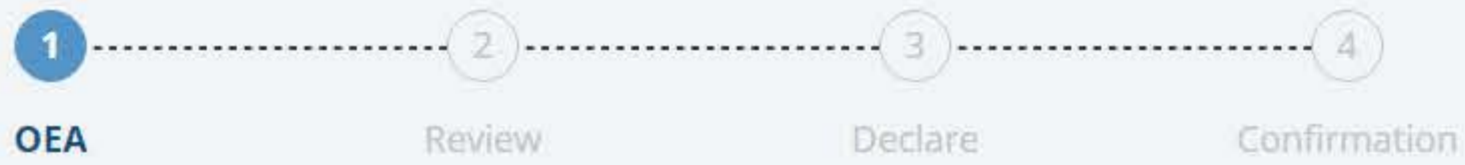
- **Particulars of every OEA platform, online account or communication service** maintained by or on behalf of the candidate on which OEA has been or is to be published; and
- **Details of any paid OEA** on each OEA platform, online account or communication service **that has been or is to be published.**

Thereafter, a **declaration must be submitted** to the Returning Officer **at any time before OEA is published.**

You will need to **provide all information to the fullest extent possible** in your declaration. If required, the Returning Officer may contact you to seek clarifications or to request for additional information.

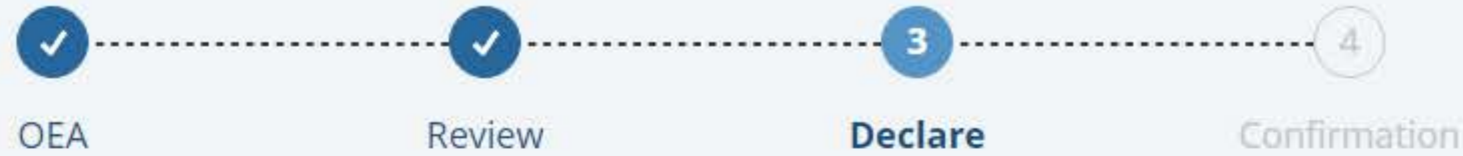
