No. 1957 — PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT (CHAPTER 218)

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 13(5)

In accordance with section 13(5) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, notice is hereby given that the Registration Officer intends to do the following on 3rd August 2011 pursuant to section 13(4) and (4A), respectively of the Act:

- (a) to remove from any register of elector the name of any person where the Registration Officer has reason to believe that the address of that person as shown in the register has ceased to exist or to be used as his place of residence or his contact address; and
- (b) to transfer the name of any person to the appropriate register of electors where the person has notified the Commissioner of National Registration in writing of his change of address or contact address.

The list of the names of persons removed from any register of electors under section 13(4) of the Act, and the list of the names of persons transferred from a register of electors to another register of electors under section 13(4A) of the Act, will be available for inspection at the office of the Registration Officer at 11 Prinsep Link, Singapore 187949 during the following hours:

- (a) between 8.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. daily on Mondays to Fridays (except public holidays);
- (b) between 8.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturdays (except public holidays).
