ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Prescribed date
- 3. Revocation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 (4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 26th September 2001.

Prescribed date

2. For the purposes of section 5 (1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date shall be 31st August in any year instead of 1st July.

Revocation

3. The Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order (O 4) is revoked.
