In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 (4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 26th September 2001.

**Prescribed date**

**2.** For the purposes of section 5 (1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date shall be 31st August in any year instead of 1st July.

**Revocation**

**3.** The Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order (O 4) is revoked.
