In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8A (1) (b) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the President hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Designation of Group Representation Constituencies) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 17th October 2001.

**Designation of group representation constituencies**

- 2.** The group representation constituencies specified —
- (a) in Part I of the Schedule are designated under section 8A (1) (b) (i) of the Act as constituencies where at least one of the candidates in each group shall be a person belonging to the Malay community; and
  - (b) in Part II of the Schedule are designated under section 8A (1) (b) (ii) of the Act as constituencies where at least one of the candidates in each group shall be a person belonging to the Indian or other minority communities.

**Revocation**

**3.** The Parliamentary Elections (Designation of Group Representation Constituencies) Order (O 2) is revoked.
