**No. 2881 — PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT (CHAPTER 218)**

(Section 25)

NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR ALL ELECTORAL DIVISIONS

The President having issued his Writ for the election of Members of Parliament for all Electoral Divisions, the Returning Officer will on the 25th day of October 2001, between 11 a.m. and 12 noon at the places of nomination specified in the Schedule to the Writ for each electoral division, proceed to the nomination and, if there is no opposition, to the election of a Member or Members of Parliament for the respective Electoral Divisions.

Forms of nomination papers may be obtained at the office of the Returning Officer between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. daily except on Saturday when the office will be closed at 1 p.m. (Sunday excepted).

Every nomination paper of any candidate or group of candidates must be signed by any 6 or more electors qualified to vote in the Electoral Division in which the candidate or group of candidates seeks election, and must be handed to the Returning Officer between 11 a.m. and 12 noon at the place of nomination specified in the Schedule to the Writ for that Electoral Division.

No nomination paper shall be valid or acted upon by the Returning Officer unless it is accompanied by —

- (a) the consent in writing of the person or persons therein nominated;
- (b) for each candidate, a deposit of the sum of \$13,000 in cash, or a bank draft or a certified cheque for that amount;
- (c) a statutory declaration under section 27(3) or 27B(3)(a), as the case may be, of the Act; and
- (d) if the Electoral Division is a group representation constituency, the certificate required to be delivered by any candidate in a group under section 27B(3)(c) of the Act.

The office of the Returning Officer is situate at the Elections Department, 11 Prinsep Link, Singapore 187949.
