Whereas by Article 65(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, it is provided that the President may at any time, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, dissolve Parliament if he is advised by the Prime Minister to do so:

And whereas the President has been so advised by the Prime Minister to dissolve Parliament on the 18th day of October 2001:

Now, therefore, I, S R NATHAN, President of the Republic of Singapore, do hereby proclaim and make known that Parliament shall be dissolved on the 18th day of October 2001.
