- (b) a deposit of \$37,500 in cash, or a bank draft or a certified cheque for that amount:
- (c) a statutory declaration referred to in section 9 (3) (c) of the Presidential Elections Act:
- (d) a political donation certificate issued by the Registrar of Political Donations under section 18 (4) of the Political Donations Act (Cap. 236); and
- (e) a certificate issued by the Presidential Elections Committee under section 8 (2) of the Presidential Elections Act.
