# PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS (PRESCRIBED DATE) ORDER 2009

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Prescribed date
- 3. Revocation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 17th February 2009.

### **Prescribed date**

**2.** For the purposes of section 5(1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date shall be 1st February in any year instead of 1st July.

#### Revocation

**3.** The Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2006 (G.N. No. S 1/2006) is revoked.
