### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Order:

# Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on 6th February 2014.

#### Prescribed date

**2.** For the purposes of section 5(1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date shall be 1st February in any year instead of 1st July.

### Revocation

**3.** The Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2011 (G.N. No. S 3/2011) is revoked.
