No. 1173 — PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT (CHAPTER 218)

WRIT OF ELECTION

To: THE RETURNING OFFICER

Whereas section 24(1) of the Parliamentary Elections Act provides that for the purposes of every general election of Members of Parliament, and for the purposes of the election of Members to supply vacancies caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the President shall issue writs under the public seal, addressed to the Returning Officer:

And whereas the seat of the Elected Member for the Electoral Division of Bukit Batok has become vacant:

Now, therefore, I, TONY TAN KENG YAM, the President, do require that, after notice of the time and place fixed for the nomination of candidates has been given in accordance with the Parliamentary Elections Act, you do on 27 April 2016 at Keming Primary School (School Hall Building), Bukit Batok East Avenue 6, Singapore 659762, cause election to be made according to the Act for the election of the Member for the Electoral Division of Bukit Batok, and that, if necessary, you do cause a poll to be taken on the date required to be notified under section 34(6)(d) of the Parliamentary Elections Act.
