**PUBLIC ORDER  
(AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 June 2017.

**Deletion and substitution of regulation 2**

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Order Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 487/2009) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

**“Non-application to election meetings**

2. These Regulations do not apply to the following public assemblies:

- (a) any public assembly to which the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 486/2009) apply;
- (b) any public assembly to which the Public Order (Election Meetings in Presidential Elections) Regulations 2017 (G.N. No. S 273/2017) apply.”.
