PUBLIC ORDER ACT (CHAPTER 257A)

PUBLIC ORDER (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 June 2017.

Deletion and substitution of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Order Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 487/2009) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

"Non-application to election meetings

- **2.** These Regulations do not apply to the following public assemblies:
 - (a) any public assembly to which the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 486/2009) apply;
 - (b) any public assembly to which the Public Order (Election Meetings in Presidential Elections) Regulations 2017 (G.N. No. S 273/2017) apply.".
