PUBLIC ORDER ACT (CHAPTER 257A)

PUBLIC ORDER (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Composition of Offences) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 June 2017.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Order (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2016 (G.N. No. S 250/2016) is amended —

(a) by deleting the words “(Election Meetings)” in paragraph (b) and substituting the words “(Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections)”; and

(b) by deleting the full-stop at the end of paragraph (c) and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following paragraph:

“(d) an offence under regulation 9(4), (6) or (7) or 10(3) of the Public Order (Election Meetings in Presidential Elections) Regulations 2017 (G.N. No. S 273/2017).”.
