PROCLAMATION

BY HALIMAH YACOB,
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE

Whereas by Article 66 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, it is provided that there shall be a general election at such time, within 3 months after every dissolution of Parliament, as the President shall, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, appoint:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Article 66 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, I, HALIMAH YACOB, President of the Republic of Singapore, do proclaim that the nomination day and polling day of the general election shall be within 3 months after 23 June 2020, the date of dissolution of Parliament, at such time or times as may be determined in accordance with the Parliamentary Elections Act (Chapter 218).
