No. 2346 — PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS ACT 1991

Section 6(3)

WRIT OF ELECTION

BY MR LEE HSIEN LOONG, PRIME MINISTER OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE.

TO: THE RETURNING OFFICER

WHEREAS section 6(2) of the Presidential Elections Act 1991 provides that, for the purposes of every election to the office of President of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister must issue the writ under the public seal, addressed to the Returning Officer:

AND WHEREAS I think it is expedient that the writ should now be issued for the election of a President of the Republic of Singapore:

NOW, therefore, I, LEE HSIEN LOONG, Prime Minister do require that, after notice of the time and place fixed for the nomination of candidates has been given in accordance with the Presidential Elections Act 1991, you do on 22 August 2023 at PEOPLE'S ASSOCIATION (BLOCK 1A AND AUDITORIUM), 9 KING GEORGE'S AVENUE, SINGAPORE 208581, cause election to be made according to that Act for the election of the President of the Republic of Singapore and that, if necessary, you do cause a poll to be taken on the date to be notified under section 16(5) of the Presidential Elections Act 1991.
