PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT 1954

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS (POLLING STATIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Parliamentary Elections Act 1954, the Prime Minister makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Parliamentary Elections (Polling Stations) (Amendment) Regulations 2024 and come into operation on 14 June 2024.

Amendment of regulation 1

2. In the Parliamentary Elections (Polling Stations) Regulations 2019 (G.N. No. S 233/2019) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations), in regulation 1, before “Polling Stations”, insert “Ordinary”.

Amendment of regulation 2

3. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 2 —
- (a) in the regulation heading, after “Act”, insert “**for ordinary polling station**”; and
 - (b) in paragraph (1), replace “The” with “For an ordinary polling station, the”.

Amendment of regulation 3

4. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 3 —
- (a) in the regulation heading, before “**polling station**”, insert “**ordinary**”;

- (b) replace “a polling station” with “an ordinary polling station”; and
- (c) in paragraphs (a) and (b), before “polling station”, insert “ordinary”.
