PROCLAMATION

By Tharman Shanmugaratnam, President of the Republic of Singapore

By Article 66 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, there shall be a general election at such time, within 3 months after every dissolution of Parliament, as the President shall, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, appoint:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Article 66 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, I, THARMAN SHANMUGARATNAM, President of the Republic of Singapore, proclaim that the nomination day and polling day of the general election shall be within 3 months after 15 April 2025, the date of dissolution of Parliament, at such time or times as may be determined in accordance with the Parliamentary Elections Act 1954.
