 - i. **Overview of venue set-up,** inclusive of stage set-up, barricades deployment plan¹, identified pick-up and drop-off points for candidates, speakers and supporters, identified ingress and egress routes for candidates, speakers and supporters, and access control measures put in place for the election meeting;
 - ii. **Estimated number of supporters who will turn up** at the venue versus the carrying capacity of the venue;
 - iii. **Overview of crowd and traffic control plans**, inclusive of the number of personnel deployed for crowd and traffic control duties, their location of deployment and their tasking, as well as the type, design and locations of directional and event signage to be deployed for the election meeting;
 - iv. Measures put in place to ensure the election meeting does not cause significant inconvenience to the general public; and
 - v. Measures to deal with overcrowding at the event venue.
