- O Polling agents at ordinary polling stations may be appointed by a candidate, his election agent or the principal election agent of a group of candidates. The role of a polling agent is to observe that polling at the polling station of the electoral division the candidate/group of candidates is contesting in is carried out in accordance with the law. He must also maintain secrecy of voting at all times.

At the first polling station a polling agent visits, he must submit a duly completed *Oath of Secrecy* and *Appointment of Polling Agent* form (original signed and attested copy) to the election officials. He will be issued a re-entry card with a sticker indicating his *Oath of Secrecy* form has been submitted. For entry into other polling station(s) subsequently, he is only required to present a new duly completed *Appointment of Polling Agent* form and his re-entry card from the first polling station.

A polling agent may board the vehicle transporting the sealed ballot boxes from polling stations to the counting centres of the electoral division the candidate/group of candidates is contesting in. He must submit the duly completed and signed *Indemnity* form to the election officials at that polling station he wishes to board the vehicle from, before 6pm on Polling Day. Only one polling agent per candidate/group of candidates (or the candidate himself) may board the vehicle. If there is already one polling agent representing the candidate/group of candidates on the vehicle, any other polling agent representing the same candidate/group of candidates will not be allowed to board.
