Counting agents at counting centres may be appointed by a candidate, his election agent or the principal election agent of a group of candidates. The role of a counting agent is to observe that the counting of votes at the counting centre of the electoral division the candidate/group of candidates is contesting in is carried out in accordance with the law. He must also maintain secrecy of voting at all times.

At the first counting centre a counting agent visits, he must submit a duly completed *Oath of Secrecy and Appointment of Counting Agent* form (original signed and attested copy) to the election officials. He will be issued a re-entry card with a sticker indicating his *Oath of Secrecy* form has been submitted. For entry into other counting centre(s) subsequently, he is only required to present a new duly completed *Appointment of Counting Agent* form and his re-entry card from the first counting centre.
