Submit your return respecting election expenses and declarations

Due on dd mmm

 By dd mmm, not later than the 31st day after the election result is published in the Government Gazette

 Submit online

 For each return respecting election expenses, the election agent must provide details on all expenses incurred, all disputed and unpaid claims, and all donations accepted by him or the candidate on account of or in respect of the conduct or management of the election campaign of the candidate. Both the election agent and the candidate will have to declare that the return prepared by the election agent is complete and correct, and that no other expenses of any nature have been incurred in, or for the purpose of, the candidate's candidature at that election.

Each return respecting election expenses and declarations (i.e. original return) will be made available for online inspection for 6 months starting from the date the notice setting out the online inspection location is published in the Government Gazette.

Thereafter, if there is any error or omission spotted in the original return, the election agent may correct it by submitting a fresh return annotated with what content in the original return is corrected and how it is corrected. Both the election agent and the candidate will need to submit a fresh statement and declaration, in relation to the annotated return. The election agent may make more than one application to correct the original return. However, applications to correct errors or omissions in earlier returns will not be allowed beyond 31 days after the election result is published in the Government Gazette.
