 Election advertising may be published on the Internet by a political party, candidate or election agent.

Candidate or election agent must make the **first declaration to the Returning Officer within 12 hours after the start of the campaign period**. The declaration must set out:

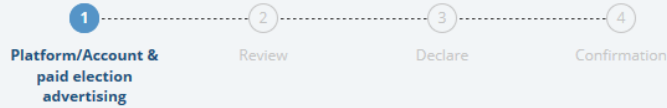
- **Particulars of every platform/account** maintained by or on behalf of the candidate on which election advertising has been or is to be published; and
- **Details of any paid election advertising on each platform/account** that has been or is to be published.

Thereafter, a **declaration** to the Returning Officer must be made **for any additional new platform/account before Internet election advertising is published on or by the platform/account**.

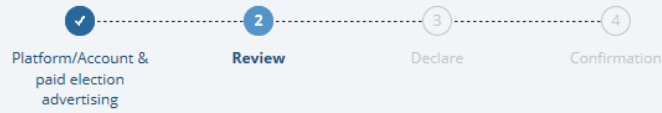

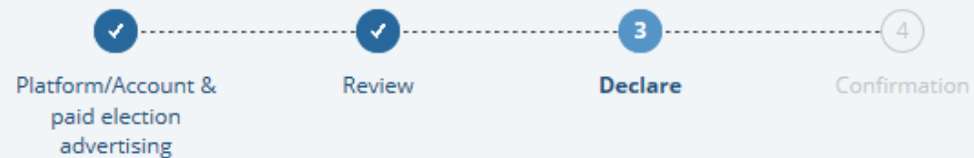

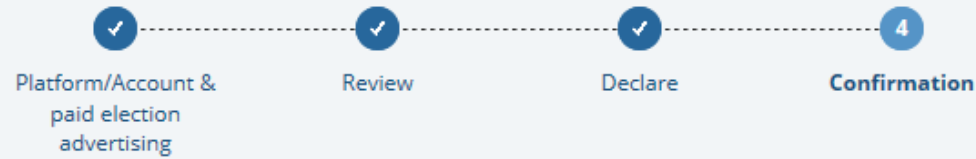
