EXHIBITION OF NON-VOTERS' LIST FOR POLLING DISTRICTS AJ24 AND AJ25

The names of persons who failed to cast their votes at the last General Election held on 6 May 2006, in polling districts AJ24 and AJ25 of Aljunied Group Representation Constituency (GRC), will be expunged from the Register of Electors of Aljunied GRC. The list of such persons will be available for inspection from 17 November 2006 onwards at the Elections Department and the following community centres/clubs in Aljunied GRC:

- (a) Aljunied Community Centre;
- (b) Ci Yuan Community Centre;
- (c) Eunoz Community Club;
- (d) Paya Lebar Kovan Community Club;
- (e) Punggol Community Club; and
- (f) The Serangoon.

All electors who failed to vote at the last General Election can apply for their names to be restored to the Registers of Electors using a prescribed application form (known as Form A). The application form can be obtained from the Elections Department or any community centres/clubs or Singapore overseas missions during their normal business hours, or downloaded from the Elections Department website at www.elections.gov.sg.

The duly completed form should be returned, by post or fax, to the Registration Officer, Elections Department, 11 Prinsep Link, Singapore 187949. The fax number is 63323428.

Applicants are required to produce documentary evidence to substantiate their inability to vote. An applicant's name will be restored without penalty if he has good and sufficient reason for not recording his vote. The penalty is \$5.
