RESTORATION OF NON-VOTERS' NAMES TO REGISTERS OF ELECTORS

Non-voters at Hougang by-election

In accordance with Section 43 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the names of those eligible voters who failed to cast their votes (i.e. non-voters) at the Hougang by-election have been expunged from the Register of Electors of Hougang Constituency. Non-voters will lose their eligibility to vote or stand as a candidate at future elections if their names are not restored to the Registers of Electors.

Checking of non-voter names that have been expunged from the Register of Electors of Hougang Constituency can be done from 1 June 2012 onwards via the eServices at www.eld.gov.sg, or at Hougang Community Club and Elections Department (original NRIC or passport should be produced for identification purposes).

Restoration of non-voter names

The restoration of non-voter names to the Register of Electors of a constituency will close once the Writ of Election for an election at that constituency is issued. Non-voters who failed to vote at the Hougang by-election or any previous parliamentary or presidential election, are encouraged to apply to have their names restored to the Registers of Electors now.

Non-voters may apply to have their names restored to the Registers of Electors using one of the following methods:-

- a) Online application at Elections Department website (http://www.eld.gov.sg).
- b) Submission of hard copy application form. The hardcopy form can be obtained from the Elections Department or any community centre/club during normal business hours, or downloaded from the Elections Department website (http://www.eld.gov.sg). The duly completed forms should be submitted (by post, fax, hand or email) to the Registration Officer, Elections Department at 11 Prinsep Link, Singapore 187949, fax number 63362006 and email contact@eld.gov.sg.

When making the application, non-voters are to state their reasons for failing to cast their votes. Valid reasons for not voting are:-

- a) Working overseas (including being on a business trip) at the time of the poll;
- b) Studying overseas at the time of the poll;

- c) Living with your spouse who is working or studying overseas;
- d) Overseas vacation which was planned before the poll; and
- e) Illness or delivering a baby.

Applicants whose names have been successfully restored to the Registers will receive notification from Elections Department within a month. Applicants who do not receive any notification within a month are advised to check their application status via the Elections Department's eServices or contact the Elections Department [email contact@eld.gov.sg or telephone 1800-CALL-ELD (1800-225-5353)].
