### CERTIFICATION OF REGISTERS OF ELECTORS

The Registers of Electors have been certified on 15 Apr 2020 and are available for public inspection. There are a total of 2,653,942 electors in the Registers.

2 Singapore Citizens may check their particulars in the Registers electronically:

- (a) At [Voter Services](#) on ELD website;
- (b) At "Profile" (under "Registers of Electors") in SingPass Mobile app.

#### Restoration of name to Registers

3 Persons whose names were removed from the Registers for failing to vote at a past election may still apply to have their names restored to the Registers via [Voter Services](#) on the ELD website, so that they can vote at future elections. They are encouraged to apply early as, under the law, we will not be able to restore their names during the period from the date the Writ for an election is issued until after Nomination Day if the election is not contested, or until after Polling Day if a poll is to be taken.

#### Registration as overseas elector

4 Overseas Singaporeans, who have resided in Singapore for an aggregate of at least 30 days during the 3-year period between 1 Mar 2017 and 29 Feb 2020, may also apply to register as overseas electors to vote at one of the designated overseas polling stations as listed in Annex A.

5 We encourage eligible overseas Singaporeans to register or re-register as soon as possible using [Voter Services](#) on ELD website as, under the law, applications will not be processed during the period from the 3<sup>rd</sup> day after the Writ for an election is issued until after Nomination Day if the election is uncontested, or until after Polling Day if a poll is to be taken.
