VOTER INFORMATION ON USE OF PASSPORT AT POLLING STATIONS AND CHANGE IN REGISTERED ADDRESS

Since the announcement of the Writ of Election on 23 June 2020, the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) has seen a surge in requests for Identity Card (IC) services, especially for the replacement of ICs, collection of new ICs and change of address. The Elections Department (ELD) would like to assure Singaporeans that the Singapore passport can be used in lieu of the NRIC on Polling Day.

2 ELD would also like to inform Singaporeans that the address on their poll card is based on the cut-off date of 1 March 2020 for the preparation of the Registers of Electors. Voters are assigned their polling stations based on their registered addresses as of that date.
