### **ISSUANCE OF COMMUNITY CERTIFICATE FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION 2023**

A person desiring to be elected as President must submit a community declaration to the Community Committee (CC).

2 For the purposes of the Presidential Election 2023, the Community Committee (CC) has received a total of 16 community declarations.

3 In accordance with the conclusions of the Sub-Committees, the CC has issued 5 Chinese Community Certificates and 1 Indian or other Minority Communities Certificate.

4 The CC has rejected 10 community declarations under section 8H(2)(c)<sup>1</sup> of the Presidential Elections Act 1991.
