DESTRUCTION OF BALLOT PAPERS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS USED IN PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION 2023

In accordance with the Presidential Elections Act 1991, ballot papers and other documents used in an election shall be sealed and retained in safe custody for a period of 6 months, after which they will be destroyed unless otherwise directed by order of the President. This is to ensure secrecy of the vote.

2 On 2 March 2024, all sealed boxes containing ballot papers and other documents used in the Presidential Election on 1 September 2023 will be transported from the Supreme Court, where they have been kept in safe custody, to the Tuas South Incineration Plant for destruction.

3 The Elections Department will reach out to candidates or their representatives who wish to witness the proceedings.
