Written Reply to Parliamentary Question on How Many Non-voters Have Applied to Restore Their Names to The Registers of Electors Since the Conclusion of Presidential Election 2023

Question:

Mr Leong Mun Wai: To ask the Prime Minister (a) since the conclusion of the 2023 Presidential Election, how many non-voters have applied to restore their names to the Registers of Electors; and (b) how many of these applications are successful.

Written Reply by Mr Chan Chun Sing, Minister of Education, for the Prime Minister:

As of end January 2024, 101,464 non-voters from the 2023 Presidential Election applied to restore their names to the Registers of Electors. All the applications were successful.
