CHECKING OF VOTER STATUS AND RESTORATION OF NON-VOTERS TO REGISTERS OF ELECTORS

In accordance with Section 43 of the Parliamentary Elections Act 1954, the names of eligible voters who failed to cast their votes (referred to as non-voters) at General Election 2025 have been removed from the Registers of Electors.

- 2 From 30 May 2025, Singapore Citizens will be able to check their particulars and voter status, as well as apply to restore their names to the Registers (if needed) via:
 - (a) Voter Services (https://www.eld.gov.sg/online.html) at the ELD website; or
 - (b) "My Profile" on Singpass App (see Annex A).
- Those who are unable to check their particulars in the Registers electronically may do so at any Community Centre/Club or ServiceSG Centre¹, or at the ELD office by making an e-appointment via ELD website or by calling 1800-225-5353. Overseas Singaporeans who cannot do so on-line may check their particulars at Singapore overseas missions serving as overseas registration centres².
- We encourage non-voters to apply to restore their names to the Registers so that they can vote at the next election. Under the law, ELD will not be able to restore their names from the date the Writ for an election is issued until after Nomination Day if the election is not contested, or until after Polling Day if a poll is to be taken.
